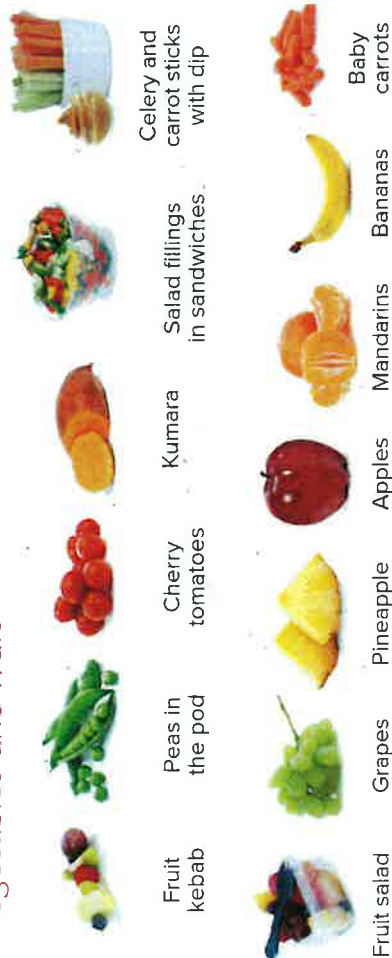

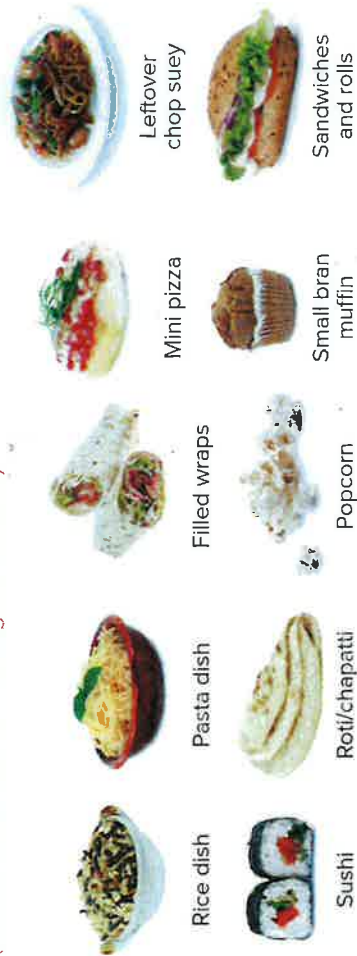


Pack a lunch so good it won't come home! A lunchbox should include at least one item from each of the four food groups:

Vegetables and fruit



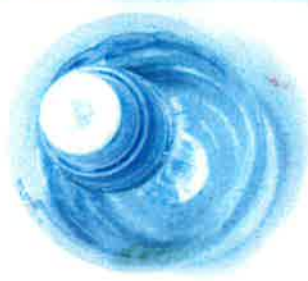
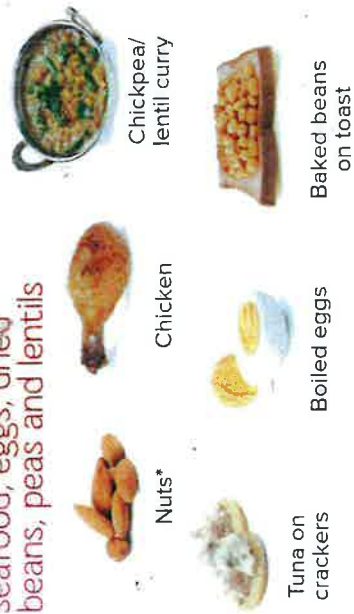
Breads and cereals (include wholemeal and wholegrain varieties)
